Day 1-2: Leave Provo on the California Zephyr train to see spectacular views on the way to San Francisco. We will stay 4 nights in beautiful downtown San Francisco close to many fun sites and activities.

Day 3: Visit sites around San Francisco including Fisherman's Wharf, Pier 39, Ghirardelli Square and the Cable Car Museum.

Day 4: Golden Gate Park, Lombard Street and Coit Tower, OR take an optional day trip to Yosemite (see reverse for information.)

Day 6: Return home to Provo (flight from Oakland— see reverse for more information)

*Come along on our Yosemite 1 Day tour that also takes you to the Giant Sequoias Tree. This Yosemite & Giant Sequoias tour maximizes your time in the park and lets you spend around 5-6 hours in Park, more than any other tour operator. You also have the option to go on a hike that lasts approximately 1 mile to see the Giant Sequoias Trees. You will visit sites throughout Yosemite Valley such as El Capitan, Yosemite Falls and Half-Dome to take pictures and hear their history. Price for this particular tour is \$147 and will pick-up/drop-off at our hotel. Price does not include meals.*

**Waiver of Liability/ Hold Harmless Agreement**

I, the undersigned participant, am participating in a trip to **San Francisco– September 2017.**

In consideration of my participation in this trip, I hereby waive all claims or causes of action against the Springville Senior Citizens Organization, the City of Springville, Utah, its auxiliary organizations, and the officers, directors, employees and agents of all of them, all of which are collectively hereinafter referred to as the Senior Center, arising out of my participation in the activity and hereby release, hold harmless, and discharge the Senior Center from all liability in connection therewith.

Travel fees or Yosemite tour fees will be due upon booking.  
Remaining Balance is due June 16th.**
