


#### **BLOTHWYN'S BOTHER**



Queen Blothwyn is offering a prize of one dozen dragon's eggs to anyone who can solve the following problem.


- Start in the white square at corner A of the chessboard below.

- Enter each square through one of its corners.




- 5. Never enter a black square.
